

Lecturers code of conduct

- the lecturer creates, supports and safekeeps a proper learning environment during the course
- the lecturer cooperates with their colleagues and other professionals for the cause of teaching children
- the lecturer helps develop the intellectual, emotional and social potential of the child
- the lecturer helps develop the intellectual, creative and ethical part of the pupil's character
- the lecturer themselves educates themselves and develops their abilities
- the lecturer cooperates with the parents and school, builds their trust and respects their right for privacy
- the lecturer mustn't misuse their standing towards the child
- the lecturer sees their job as their vocation
- the lecturer must be an upstanding person and they must be aware that they are a paragon for the children
- the lecturer must be righteous and just; they mustn't give preferential treatment to any one child and treat them all equally

Twelve rules of conduct during the course/at the summer camp

- 1. we are a team we help each other and work together
- 2. we act kindly, we greet all adults and children the lecturer is an example to the children
- 3. we use words like please, sorry, excuse me, thanks etc.
- 4. we avoid vulgar expressions
- 5. we do not tolerate any form of bullying, discrimination or any violence
- 6. if there so happens to be a fight between the children, we work towards defusing the situation
- 7. During the first day/course we agree how we will address each other, on how we will behave towards each other and how we will work safely
- 8. the lecturer is responsible for the children during the duration of the course
- 9. we do not force the children do do anything but we do not do their work for them we motivate them
- 10. we do not use the phone during the duration of the course/camp for entertainment
- 11. we make good on our promises
- 12. we recycle and clean up after we are done
